## Introduction & Background

The IWAS Powerchair Hockey (PCH) Qualification Tournament took place from the 8th till the 13th October 2019 in Prague, Czech Republic.

This event was organized under the aegis of the IWAS and the IPCH by the Czech Sports Organization for Physically Disabled and Czech Federation of Powerchair Hockey.

In Czech Republic Powerchair Hockey has been played for 10 years now, There have been many club tournaments organized in Prague that also hosted the organization of Czech National League in 2019/2020. Czech Republic hosts in his league also Slovakian teams to support and boost the development of the sport in Slovakia as well.



## General Organization

### Organizing Committee

Organizing committee (LOC) was based on people who organize club tournaments. Players who were involved in the organization of the Qualification Tournament were then substituted so that they could concentrate just for the function of the player.

## Competition Hall

Sport Hall Economy University Trebesin was approved by IWAS IPCH Chairman (2018) and TD and TD assistant during second site inspection (2019).

Extra wheelchair accessible toilet was provided in front of the hall.



Due to the peculiar structure of the tournament, counting on 3 teams could not avoid having at least one team playing consecutive games, TD agreed to use the one field for both training and games.

The Sport Hall was also used for some meetings, hosted in the locker rooms. On one hand this allowed LOC to save some money as the meeting rooms at



the hotel were very expensive but was not the best solution for the Officials due to the lack of meeting equipment and web connection issues.

## Transportation

Transport was provided by a company by minivans plus by two VW Transporters.

## Volunteers

There were volunteers helping with the organization on a day to day basis.

For the competition days there were extra volunteers as table officials.

Also the City Police was active and involved in the volunteering tasks and activities, especially during preparation days.

# The Competition

## Allocated Nations

At the beginning of the planning and at the stage immediately following the Letter of intent IPCH also received the intention to host the EC2020 from Finland.

At that point, according to the IPCH World Ranking List, Finland would have been among those nations to be invited to a Qualification Tournament.

This situation created in fact few issues for the LOC of the QT2019 because as long as the process to evaluate the bid to host the EC2020 filed by Finland there could not be any sure information about the number of participating teams and therefore on the match schedule.

## Match Schedule

The competition was played according to the IPCH Competition Regulation art. C.2.2. "In competitions of 3 participating teams, the teams play 2 times against each other. All matches shall be played."

## Closing Ceremony


Closing ceremony including the Prize award ceremony was held in the hall after the final game. In addition, in the evening there was farewell dinner in the hotel with additional individual awards.
